We were wonderfully hosted by our new friends Michael and Darlene Goodling.



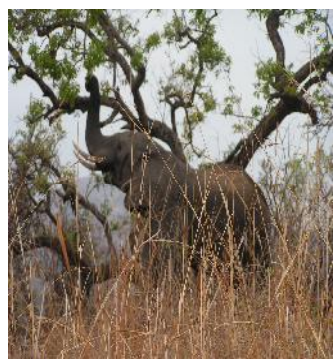
An evening by the sea in Greece
